COVID PROTOCOL 2022
TO BE STRICTLY ADHEREED TO

The following protocol to be adhered to by all the Exhibitors and Show Stewards. This is to provide a seamless and safe system within the Domestic and Horticultural Tent.

- There will be a smaller tent this year, so there will be less competitions in each section.
- No cookery/preserves/bread competitions or teenage section.
- ALN section will be one competition.
- Children's section entries taken and displayed on the day as usual.
- All other sections entries to be given by phone in the weeks leading up to the show and displays to be dropped off the day before (**Tuesday evening**).
- Handicraft section will take the form of an exhibition rather than competition to avoid touching of exhibits. These will be received the week before for the ladies to set up in the tent on **Tuesday afternoon**.
- Day of the show- 4 entries into tent and a one-way system. A steward will be monitoring the volume of people and if needs be, asking people to wait in an orderly fashion outside the tent until there is space.
- Prize giving will take place outside the tent.
- Face covering to be worn at each individual's discretion.
